

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF CHAPTER XIX (TRAFFIC) OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BELMAR

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of Belmar, County of Monmouth, New Jersey, that Chapter XIX Traffic, of the Borough of Belmar Revised General Ordinances is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION I. 19-46.2 Handicapped Parking Limited to Specific Persons in Front of Certain Residences.

ADDRESS	#SPACES	SIDE	LOCATION
611 1/2 Twelfth Avenue	1	South	Beginning at the southeast corner of Twelfth Avenue and Main Street along the southerly curbline, east 226 Feet and continuing 25 feet to the front of the space.

SECTION II. 19-14 PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS.

ADDRESS	SIDES	LOCATION
14 th Avenue	South	Beginning from Leon Lane and going 20 feet west
D Street	East	Between 6 th and 7 th Avenues

SECTION III. 19-39.1 Designated Taxicab Stands.

- b. From 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. the following areas shall be used only by taxicabs which have not been issued a Belmar Taxicab License:
- 8. Sixteenth Avenue, south side, beginning at Main Street and continuing west to Railroad Avenue
 - 9. Eighth Avenue, south side, beginning at Plaza Entrance and continuing west to Railroad Avenue

SECTION IV. 19-12 Parking Time Limited on Certain Streets.

ADDRESS	SIDES	LOCATION
11 th Avenue Crescent – west side of Main Street	Outer Edge	2 Hour Parking with the exception of the North side outer edge of the crescent from Main Street to the parking lot egress.

SECTION IV. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION V. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION VI. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.
