

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-

**RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE INSERTION OF A SPECIAL ITEMS OF
REVENUE IN THE BUDGET OF THE BOROUGH OF BELMAR PURSUANT TO
N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 (CHAPTER 159, P.L. 1948)**

WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget, and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of an item of appropriation for an equal amount, and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Belmar will receive a total of \$8600 from the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control - Cops In Shops Project and wishes to amend its 2016 Budget to include a portion of this amount as a revenue; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Belmar will receive a total of \$100,000 from the State of New Jersey Office of Emergency Management – Hazard Mitigation Grant (CFDA #97.039, FEMA-DR-4086-NJ-515-R), and wishes to amend its 2016 Budget to include a portion of this amount as a revenue; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the council of the Borough of Belmar hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of items of revenue in the budget of the year 2016 in the sum of \$108,600, which is now available as a revenue from:

The Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control & the State of New Jersey Office of Emergency Management

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that like sums are hereby appropriated under the caption of:

Cops In Shops Project - \$8600
Hazard Mitigation Grant - \$100,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk forward two copies of this resolution to the Director of Local Government Services.
