

Tree Protection

Winter weather can cause much damage to potted trees. To help trees survive the cold temperatures, try sinking them into the ground before winter arrives.

PREPARE SITE

Dig the hole or trench several inches deeper than the depth of the potted plant.

PLANT THE TREE

Place tree so that the crown is even with the surface. Refill the hole with soil. Gently tamp the material down to stabilize the plant, but still allow some air and moisture for the roots.

WATER

After the soil has been added, fill the hole with water to soak and settle the soil.
