Welcome to the Belmar Treasure Trail — a self-guided tour that features some of the environmental, art and historical gems that make our beautiful shore town such a special place to live and visit.

The Treasure Trail is divided into two routes.

One covers the Main Street and Shark River sections of town, with stops #1-22. It is about 4 miles and takes about 2 hours at a leisurely pace. The second route,

an Ocean area route, includes

stops #23-38. It is about

2.75 miles and takes about 1.5 hours at a

leisurely pace. If you're

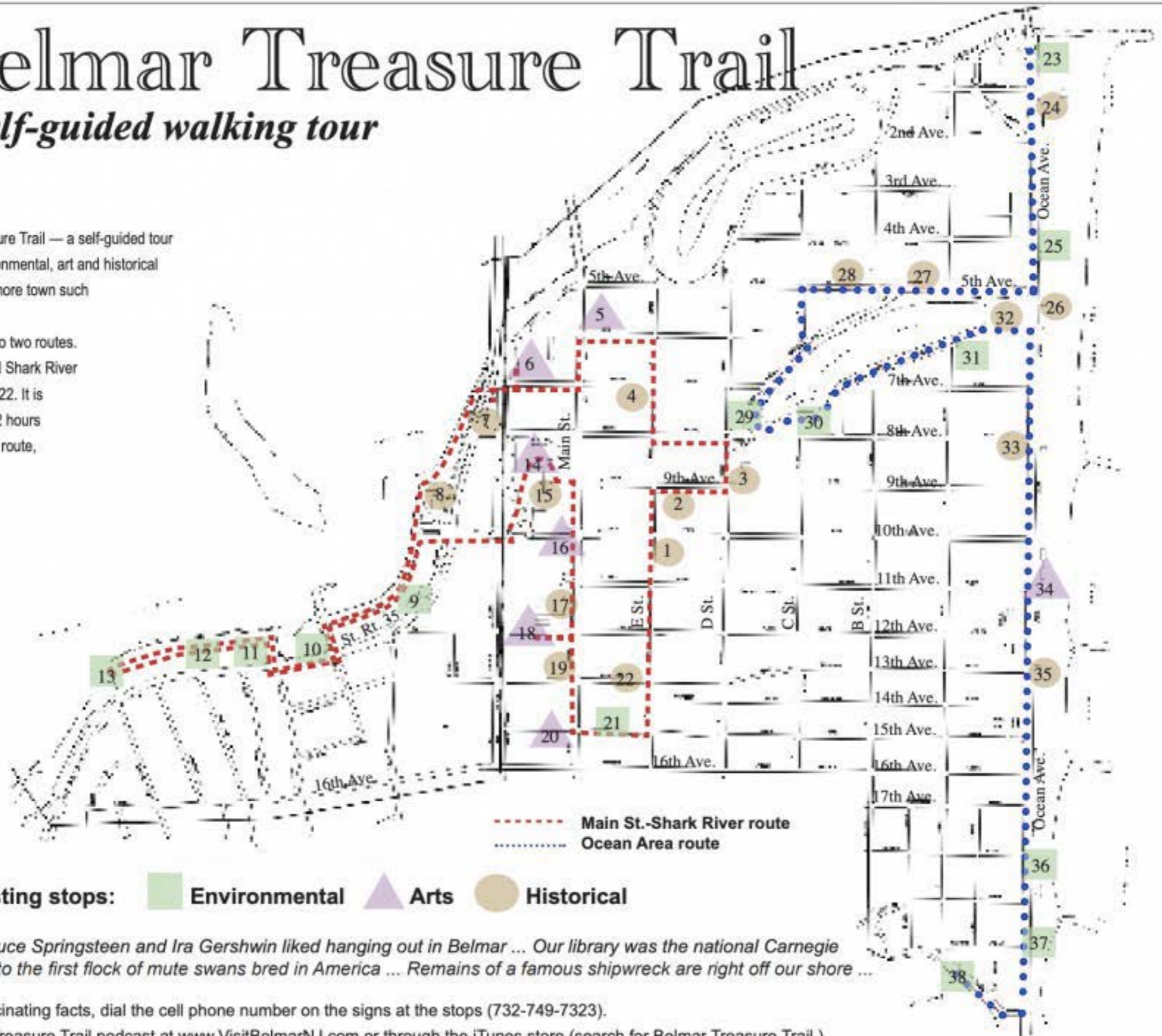
