## *A self-guided walking tour*

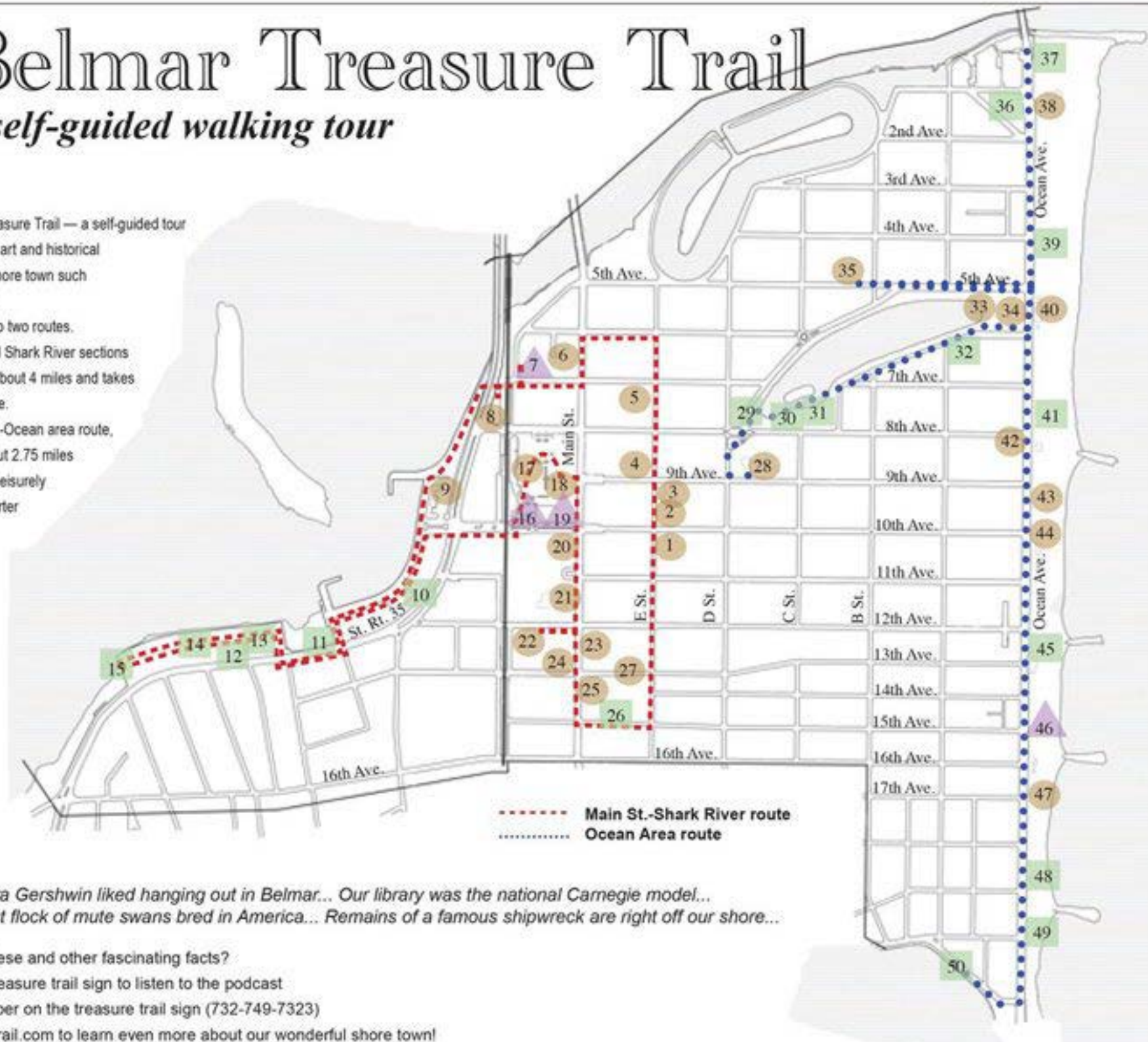
Welcome to the Belmar Treasure Trail — a self-guided tour that features 50 environmental, art and historical gems that make our beautiful shore town such a special place to live and visit.

The Treasure Trail is divided into two routes. One covers the Main Street and Shark River sections of town, with stops #1-27. It is about 4 miles and takes about 2 hours at a leisurely pace.

The second route, a Silver Lake-Ocean area route, includes stops #28-50. It is about 2.75 miles and takes about 1.5 hours at a leisurely pace. If you're looking for a shorter route, feel free to create your own. Enjoy!
